- b. Membership-
 - i. Prices increasing as of first of year to \$20 renewal or new membership with LE/Military discount, or \$25 renewal or new membership without discount.
 - ii. We need a bigger list of businesses offering discounts to our members. Chapter officers must get boots on the ground and start talking to businesses about partnering. Each partner will now receive a sticker they can put up on window or door of their business to show that they are an OC partner and offer discounts. They can also have the picture emailed as a picture so they can put it up on their website.
 - iii. We will stress to businesses that as an org, we DO NOT offer CHL classes. We find people the trainers they need. Need to focus on more than just firearm related businesses. Fed Ex will possibly offer discounts to members.

VII. New Business- 3:37-3:49 PM

- a. Members only event- Each chapter will host their own members only event with the funding of Ohio Carry in their region
- b. Ohio Carry Annual Scholarship- Anyone at a 2 or 4 year college or university or police academy is eligible. Each applicant will write a second amendment related essay. We will select the top 5-10 essays and put them up for review of all officers. We will vote to pick the winner. All 5-10 applicants will be invited to an OC statewide event to read their essays. The winner will be announced at the event.
- c. Ohio Carry inner city outreach program- Children ages 8-18 will be eligible, with younger children receiving Eddie Eagle training. Will use blue safety training guns for display and safety demonstrations. Goals will be to show that not only police and bad guys carry guns. **GOOD GUYS HAVE GUNS TOO!** We will discuss gun safety at home and will also discuss how not to act if approached by the police and you have a toy/bb/pellet gun. How to respond appropriately. Will also discuss certain firearm laws. We will look to partner with local churches to offer this outreach.
